

PRECAUTION FOR INSTALLATION AND USE

- The operating temperature should be between 4°C and 36°C
- To prevent degrade of sound quality and malfunction do not install in places with significant vibration, exposed to direct sunlight, in extremely hot places, in places with high humidity or bad ventilation, places exposed to rain or other water.
- Do not place anything on the unit
- Do not expose to fast reduction of temperature because condensation could occur with possible damaging of the apparatus. If this happens, leave the unit for one or two hours before turning the unit on.

OVERVIEW


The 501 / x system was designed having in mind the needs of closed rooms where music must coexist with the use of a microphone for the voice, as in the case of entertainment at party. The system provides an innovative management of music and voice programs and has an output section designed for the use of satellite systems + subwoofer. We recommend using the system in combination with the AR series loudspeakers and SB301 subwoofers, compact systems that integrate easily in all architectural conditions

The system provides separate line inputs for music and voice, amplified outputs for a stereo speaker system plus subwoofer line. The front panel allows direct and separate adjustment of the audio levels of speakers and subwoofers. Through dedicated software it is possible to configure the system parameters, the sub cut, enable the microphone feedback suppressor and other adjustments such as equalizers and dynamics.

FRONT PANEL

In the front panel is located:

- (1) VU METER, this METER indicates the input sound level, regulate the gain in the source to have a level that use all the dynamic but in the red limit of the METER.
- (2) Red LED that indicates an overload on the amplifier modules, restart the device if this is on and reduce the sound level.




- (3) Main volume regulation, this KNOB regulates the output level of the amplifier section
- (4) Subwoofer volume regulation, this KNOB regulates the output level of the subwoofer amplifier section
- (5) Power on switch

- (1) The power supply inlet (speakon)
- (2) Subwoofer connection clamps
- (3) Speakers' connection clamps
- (4) USB plug for PC connection.
- (5) Line pass-through output, XLR balanced line
- (6) Music line input, XLR balanced line
- (7) Voice line input, XLR balanced line

REAR PANEL


In the rear panel there are all the connection interface. Following the details:





CONNECTIONS




The system has two line inputs, one for the voice program and one for the music. For example, you can work using a mixer output bus to which voice channels are assigned and one to which music channels are assigned. An output is available with the sum of the two input signals. Line input and output are XLR balanced type.



The connection are according the standards, following the details:


- 1 GND

The powered output are clamp type.




Two clamps are for subwoofer connection, four clamps are for speakers connection.

REAR HOLDER SUPPORT



To simplify the mounting in standard rack-mount chassis the system is equipped with a adjustable flange.



Make a measuring of the depth in the chassis, adjust the position of the flang (2) according the measure and fix the 4 screws (1).
